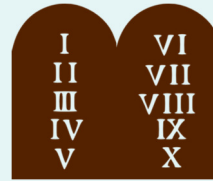

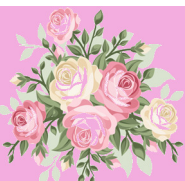
First Holy Communion

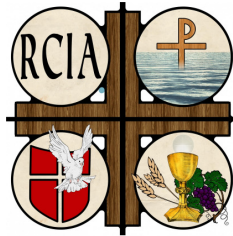
