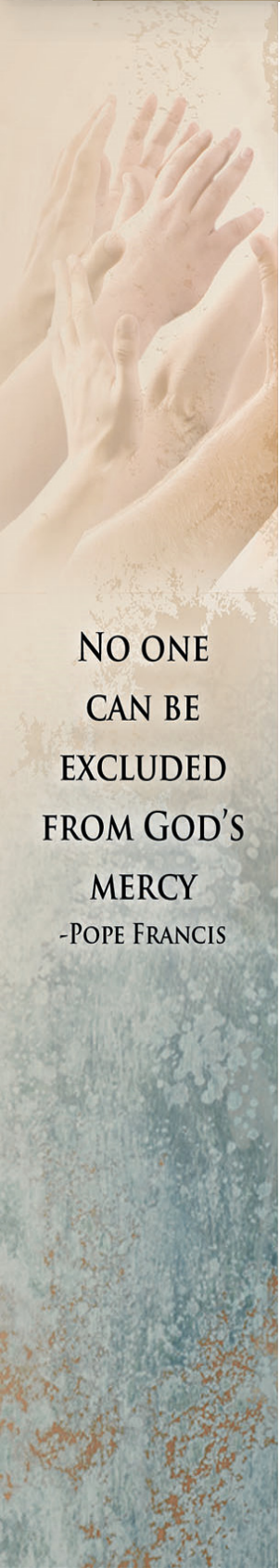

TWENTY-SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Though our Lord Jesus Christ was rich, he became poor, so that by his poverty you might become rich.



It is among our deepest beliefs that Jesus called us to take care of the poor. Jesus tells us he will judge us by our treatment of him in our fellow humans. Six of the seven corporal works of mercy are listed in the Gospel today. Just as Jesus received his place at the right hand of the Father in heaven by self-sacrifice we will receive our place in the kingdom by feeding the hungry, giving drink to the thirsty, making strangers welcome, clothing the naked, visiting the sick, visiting the imprisoned. It is a very challenging Gospel. But God has given us the grace of people in every age who lived this Gospel and they are examples to us.
